What is Project *NEXT*?

All post-secondary students (at 2- or 4-year colleges/universities) in Northeast Ohio who have either a documented Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) or Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) are eligible to participate in Project *NEXT* and receive one-year of academic and career support services.

Project *NEXT* focuses on utilizing Cognitive Support Technology (CST) and vocational rehabilitation services to provide students support in excelling in the classroom and transitioning from college to a career of their choice.
