ALTERNATIVE TESTING DURING FINAL EXAMS WEEK

Are you planning to utilize your alternative testing accommodations for your final exams this semester? If so, please remember the following and be sure to contact the Office of Accessibility if you have any questions.

- Final exam requests must be submitted in STARS at least 1 full week in advance.
- Submitting late final exam requests often results in the request being denied due to space, time, or staff restrictions.
- Communicate with your instructors about when and where you will be taking their final exam
- Be sure to schedule your finals at a time that allows you to utilize your full time extension before your testing location closes.
- Arrive early to your scheduled exams to make sure you are able to start right on time.
- Get lots of rest, and be sure to attend study groups and review sessions.

INCLEMENT WEATHER AT UA





ENROLL FOR SPRING 2020 CLASSES
