This year, record numbers of students and employers attended the Fall 2007 Career Fair making it a huge success for students, employers and the CCM.

The total number of student attendees reached 632, up 20% from the Fall 2006 Career Fair. Registered employers totaled 115! Over 100 employers have already registered for our Spring Career Fair, which will take place on February 15th, 2008.

Employers participated from well known area companies

such as First Energy and Good-year. However there were also recruiters from all over the country including the Peace



Corps, American Greetings, Target, and Cintas to name a few. The career fair not only offered a variety of companies, but also

recruited students from almost every major of field.

Both students and employers had great networking experiences during the fair.
