A graduate of Harvard College, recently retired Myers joined Myers Industries in 1967, working in the production department of one of the manufacturing companies. In 1971, he was named president of Akro-Mils and elected to the board of directors. He was named vice president in 1973, executive vice president in 1977, and president and chief operating officer in 1984. In 2003, Myers was named chair and chief executive officer of the company and, in 2005, he gave up the CEO position and remained chairman of the board. Annual sales of Myers Industries are \$780.0M.

An active supporter of many community organizations and philanthropies, Myers serves as a trustee of the Cleveland Museum of Art and Children's Hospital Medical Center of Akron. He is a member of the Board of Trustees for Hawken School and serves as a Director of Reko International, Wright Tool & Forge Company, OPTEM, and CardiArc. He also is a member of the Committee on University Resources for Harvard College.
