Applicants must hold a valid Ohio driver's license to enroll in this course and be 18 years of age. Following successful completion of the course, the student will have completed the curriculum guideline established by the Ohio Revised Code 4765.35. This course is designed for current law enforcement, fire service and EMS or those interested in getting into those fields. The general public is strongly encouraged to enroll in this course. Topics and practical skills include: airway management, spinal immobilization, CPR, and patient assessments.
