Scholarship awards will range from **\$500 to \$5000 renewable each year.**

1. Complete this application.
2. Complete FAFSA\* between January 1, 2008 and March 1, 2008.
3. Complete essay (by student).
4. Submit official high school transcript:
  - a. Mail in sealed envelope with application, **OR**
  - b. Have high school mail directly to address below.
5. Send ACT or SAT verification to address below.
6. Early deadline for all materials: **March 15, 2008.**
7. Standard deadline for all materials: **April 30, 2008.**

Scholarship recipients will be selected from a pool of qualified applicants. To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must be a full-time student (12 credits per semester) and meet the following criteria:

Scholarship Requirements	Criteria
Grade point average	2.8 minimum
ACT composite score **	19 minimum
SAT composite score **	910 minimum

Financial need: The exact amount provided by this scholarship will depend on the need of the student according to the FAFSA. The range will be \$500 to \$5,000 each academic year. The average award is \$2500. Each scholarship is renewable for four years with a potential of \$10,000+ for four years.

You must meet the criteria for grade point average, either the ACT or SAT test score, and financial need. Your financial need will be determined by using the FAFSA. You must complete the FAFSA, send the application in online, and have the results sent to the University of Akron. The UA FAFSA School Code is 003123. The University of Akron will determine the final figure for your financial need. See more detailed information below.

\* FAFSA = Free Application for Federal Student Aid

\*\* Only one test score, ACT **or** SAT, is required to apply for the scholarship
