### What to bring ...

#### Bed and Bath

- Bed linens: sheet set (long twin size 36x80")
- Pillow
- Bedspread/comforter
- Towels and washcloths
- Alarm clock
- Plastic bucket for shower items
- Bathrobe and shower shoes
- Hair dryer/curling iron/curlers
- Hygiene items
- First aid items

#### Kitchen Supplies

- Small cavity microwave
- Cooking/eating utensils
- Coffeemaker (no percolators)
- Small refrigerator (3.0 cu.ft. or less)
- Broom/dustpan
- Cleaning supplies

#### Clothing and Laundry

- Clothes basket/hamper
- Clothes hangers
- Umbrella/rain gear
- Detergent and fabric softener
- Season-appropriate clothing (due to space)
- Iron and small ironing board
- Sewing kit

#### Electrical Accessories

- Surge protector/power strip for all electronic equipment
- Personal computer
- Television/VCR/DVD player
- Radio/stereo (headphones encouraged)
- Desk/reading lamp and bulbs

#### Scholastic Supplies

- Desk calendar
- Notebooks, paper, etc.
- Calculator
- Pens, pencils, highlighters, etc.
- Planner
- Backpack
- Stamps and envelopes, memo board/notepads

#### Miscellaneous

- Receipts/literature from the University
- Names, addresses, telephone numbers and policy numbers of insurance companies
- Area rug
- White "tack gum" for hanging posters
- Additional wastebasket
- Small tool kit

- Electric skillet
- Hot plate
- Percolator
- Immersion heating devices
- Oil popcorn poppers
- Outlet adapters
- Toaster/toaster ovens
- Halogen lamps (without cover)
- George Foreman grills
- Air conditioner
- Electric space heaters
- Sun lamps
- Potpourri burners
- Incense burner
- Contact paper/wallpaper
- Glow-in-the-dark stars
- Candles
- Pets (except fish – tank NOT to exceed 20 gallons)
- Weapons of any kind
- Waterbeds
- Dartboards
- Nails, screws, other types of fastener hardware
- Electric blankets
