

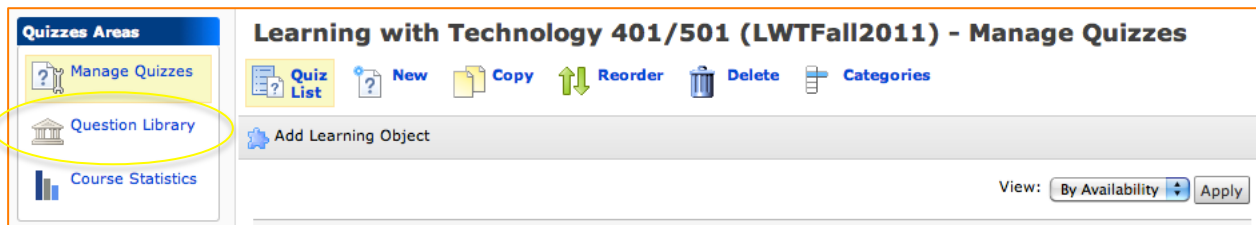
This step-by-step guide will demonstrate how to create True or False Questions within the **Quizzes** tool in Desire2Learn (D2L).

Quizzes: Create Questions – True or False

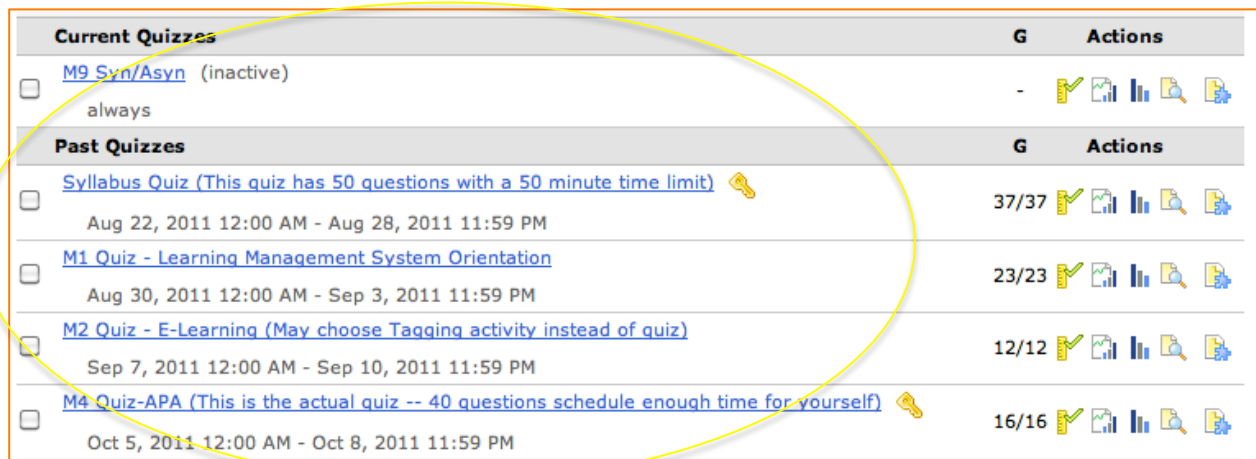
1. Select **Quizzes**.



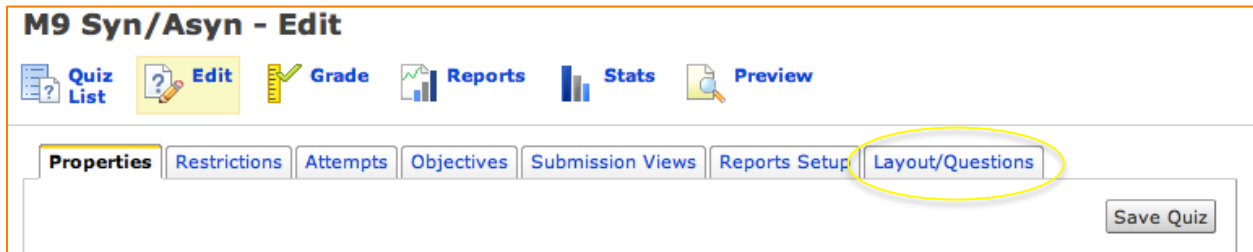
2. Select one of the following two options.
 - a. Select **Question Library** (recommended option).



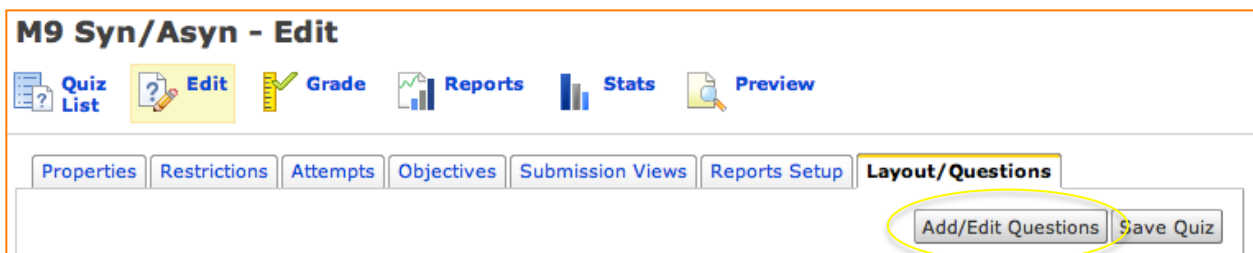
- b. Select the desired quiz.



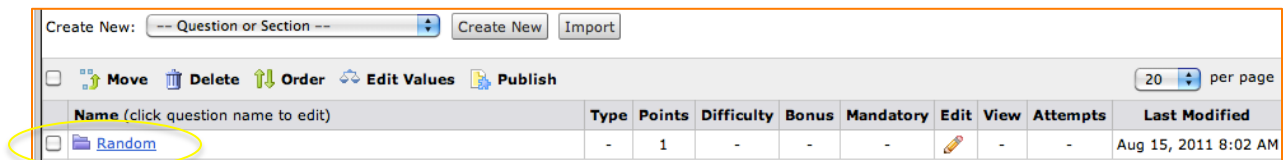
i. Select the **Layout/Questions** tab for that quiz.



ii. Select **Add/Edit Questions**.



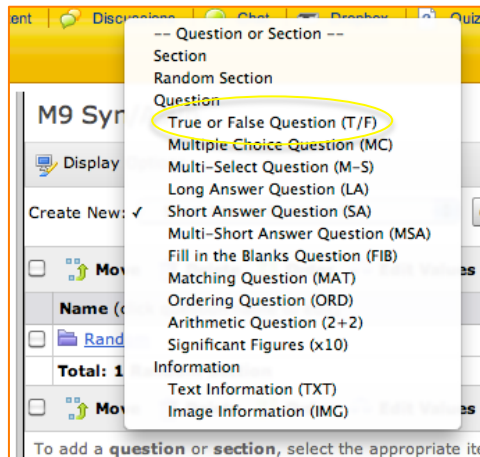
3. *Optional:* Select a **Section** into which the new question(s) will be placed.



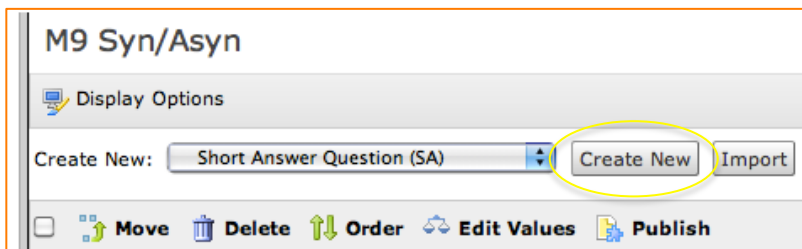

4. Select **True or False Question (T/F)** from the dropdown menu.

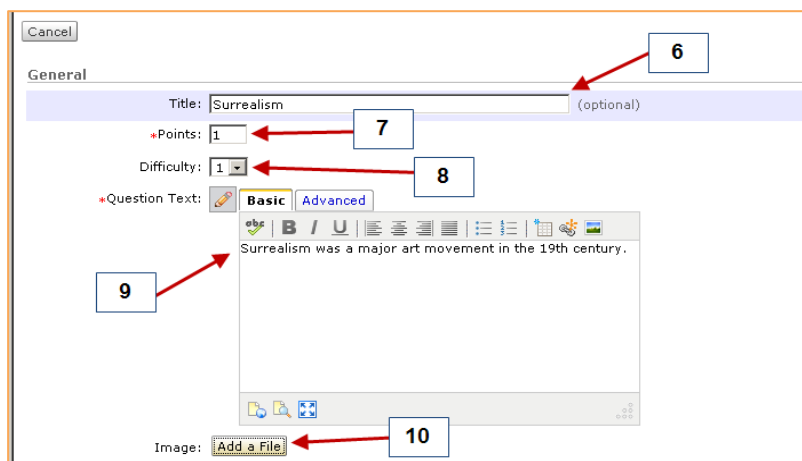


5. Select **Create New**.

9. Enter the **Question Text**.
10. *Optional*: Add an image by selecting **Add a File**.

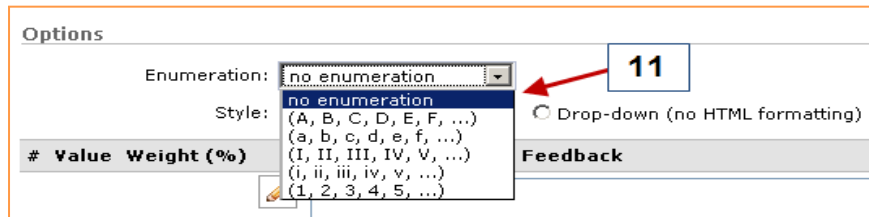


a. *Optional*: Enter a **Description** of the image.

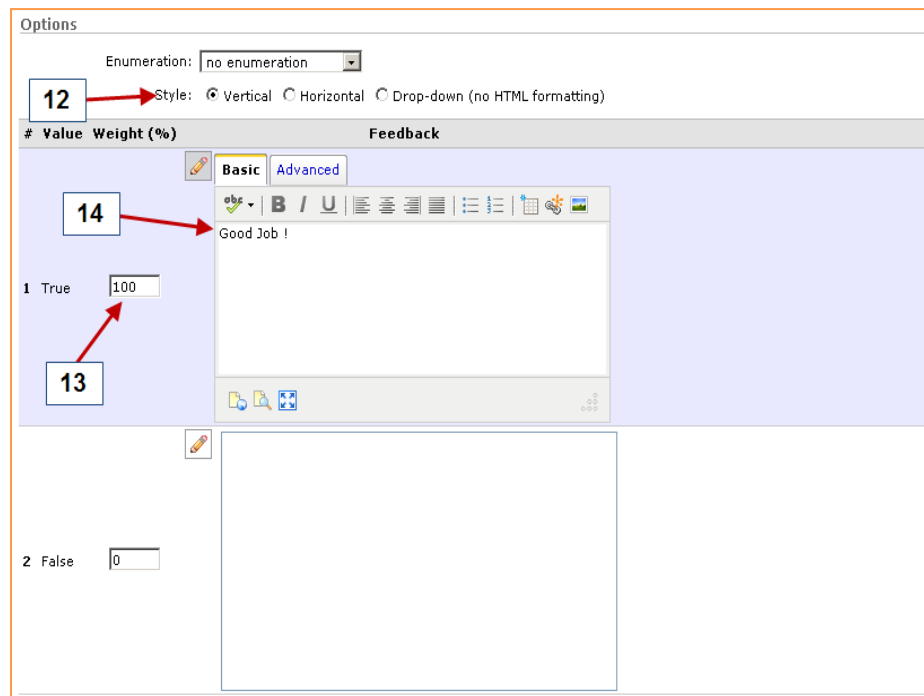
11. *Optional*: Select a type of **Enumeration** from the dropdown menu.

15. *Optional*: Enter a **Question Hint**.

16. *Optional*: Enter **Question Feedback** to display no matter what answer the user selects.
