READING ENDORSEMENT

The University of Akron Reading Endorsement prepares licensed educators to add a K-12 reading endorsement to any standard teaching license such as Early Childhood, Middle Childhood, Intervention Specialist, Adolescence to Young Adult (AYA), or Multi-Age licenses. *Applicants who have recently completed a phonics course prior to enrolling in the endorsement program will need to complete only 5 of the courses in the program or 15 graduate credit hours.*

Program Details:

- Total Hours: 15-18 graduate credit hours
- Reading Endorsement can be completed in one semester, although it is not mandatory.
