Acceptable Federal Tax Returns: 1040EZ, 1040A, 1040, or Form 1722 (transcript) from the IRS.
If an amended tax return was filed, you must submit copies of both the amended tax return AND the original.
If you and your spouse filed a joint return, but are now separated/divorced, you must provide PROOF OF SEPARATION (i.e.: legal separation papers, or letter from a professional source), and W2's to separate income.
Check here if you (and your spouse) will not file and are not required to file a 2008 Federal Income Tax Return according to IRS guidelines.
