THE UNIVERSITY OF AKRON offers you an award of scholarship/fellowship to assist you in your graduate education. This award of scholarship/fellowship shall be for the payment of graduate instructional fees at The University of Akron as follows. Recipients with under the required number of credits required for their graduate degree will receive up to the below named number of credits or amount of tuition.

This scholarship/fellowship shall be effective for the following period (check all that apply):

This award of scholarship/fellowship will automatically terminate upon conferral of the degree for which this scholarship/fellowship is provided, or upon the accumulation of two years of funding for master's students, five years of funding for doctoral students, and five years of funding for master's/doctoral students (no student will receive a tuition award from the Graduate School for more than five years), or the recipient drops below the minimum required graduate credit hours at any time during the contract period.

This scholarship/fellowship entitles you to partial payment of one parking permit, in student campus lots, for each semester or summer session of award.

A condition for your receipt of this scholarship/fellowship is that you enroll in full-time study (a minimum of 9 graduate credit hours per semester) at The University of Akron. Further, you understand that you must maintain a minimum cumulative graduate-level grade point average of 3.00 and make satisfactory progress toward the graduate degree for which this scholarship/fellowship is provided.

This scholarship/fellowship is subject to the terms and conditions of The University of Akron Policy for Graduate Scholarships, a copy of which is on the reverse side hereof. It provides for the payment of graduate instruction fees, at The University of Akron, but does not include payment of such charges as the general service fee, administrative fees, late fees, technology fees, facility fees, audit course fees, undergraduate course fees, drop/add fees, library fees, additional cost of professional fees for joint graduate/law students, miscellaneous fees, transportation fees, etc., or for payment of any fees at another University.

This scholarship/fellowship is subject to the tax laws and other applicable laws of the United States, the State of Ohio and the rules and regulations of The University of Akron, as may be amended from time to time.

### The University of Akron Policy for Graduate Scholarships

The University of Akron shall provide a scholarship for graduate instructional fees, non-resident surcharge, for up to the amount or number of credits stated on the contract and partial payment of a parking permit for student campus lots, during each semester or summer session of award period. Scholarships are not provided for audit or undergraduate courses, general service fee, administrative fees, facilities fees, technology fees, late fees, or drop/add fees, library fees, additional cost of professional fees for joint graduate/law students, miscellaneous fees, transportation fees, etc., or payment of fees at another University.

#### Repayment of Graduate Scholarships upon Resignation/Termination pursuant to University Rule 3359-60-06.6

The Graduate Scholarship Recipient is *not* required to repay any scholarship award if, during the semester of resignation/termination:

1. He or she withdraws from all classes at the time of resignation/termination, or
2. If he or she continues as an enrolled graduate student at the university of Akron after resignation from the scholarship award, then he or she must repay the scholarship based on a percentage of the number of weeks remaining in the semester or summer session.

The Graduate Scholarship Recipient is required to repay the scholarship, in full, if:

1. He or she resigns the scholarship on or prior to the 14th day of the semester, or
2. He or she remains enrolled as a graduate student at the time of resignation and does not complete the course(s) with a grade of C- or better (repayment will be based on the course(s) that a C- or better is not reached).

#### IMPORTANT:

Scholarships will not be awarded after the 14th day of any semester or session.

Graduate Scholarships will be immediately terminated should the student fall below 9 graduate credit hours during the Fall and Spring Contract Period, respectively. Student may apply and may be awarded a Graduate Scholarship for subsequent contract periods.

Graduate Scholarships terminate at the end of the Semester or Contract Period (whichever is earliest) for which the graduate degree is conferred.

Graduate Scholarships will terminate upon the accumulation of two years of funding for master's students, five years of funding for doctoral students, and five years of funding for master's/doctoral students. No student will receive a tuition award from the Graduate School for more than five years.

Graduate Scholarship recipients must adhere to University's Refund Dates - Refer to the Registrars' Office <http://www.uakron.edu/registrar/>.

The misuse of the Graduate Scholarship program may result in the denial of future Graduate Scholarships. The Graduate School retains the exclusive right to award or deny Graduate Scholarships.
