Job Summary:

Coordinates office functions and provides administrative assistance in the planning and implementation of special events and projects for coaching staff and Associate Director of Athletics.

Essential Functions:

25%-30% Maintains calendars, organizes meetings, coordinates special events and makes travel arrangements utilizing various software packages and provides related reports.

20% Researches, develops and prepares recruiting and promotional materials.

20% Coordinates searches, recruits applicants and conducts interviews and maintains related personnel and payroll files. Directs support staff and students assistants.

15% Coordinates publication relations and marketing activities. Responds to inquiries.

10% Maintains the departmental supplies inventory and related records. Prepares departmental usage reports and makes recommendations regarding expenditures.

Education:

Requires 18 months of education or training beyond high school.

Licenses/Certifications/Requirements:

None.

Experience:

Requires a minimum of 6 years experience in office/clerical procedure. Ability to take independent action as well as obtain general direction from departmental administrators required. Advanced computer knowledge including capabilities in word processing, spreadsheet, and database software packages required. Strong interpersonal skills, problem-solving skills, and research skills required. Ability to adapt to new technology and work in a fast paced environment is required.

Leadership:

Functional guidance over nonexempt staff including general scheduling, assigning tasks and monitoring work activities.

Physical Requirements:

Job is physically comfortable; individual is normally seated and has discretion about walking, standing, etc. May occasionally lift very lightweight objects.

Working Conditions:

No major sources of working conditions discomfort, standard working environment with possible minor inconveniences due to occasional noise, crowded working conditions, minor heating/cooling or ventilation problems, and/or up to 40% use of PC terminal.

The intent of this classification specification is to provide a representative summary of the types of duties and responsibilities that will be required of positions given this title and shall not be construed as a declaration of the specific duties and responsibilities of any particular position. Employees may be requested to perform job-related tasks other than those specifically presented in this description.
