# 2015 Award to Recognize Excellence in Community Engagement Criteria and Application Process



#### THE AWARD

The University of Akron recognizes and celebrates faculty, administrators, and staff that have made engagement with the community a central focus of their approach to student learning and scholarship. Recipients should demonstrate engagement in public problem-solving and excellence in scholarship that addresses critical community concerns or leadership in academic service-learning. The award will include a \$1,500 honorarium.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

Individuals who are nominated should collect, prepare, organize, and submit a portfolio containing the following materials to the Office of Academic Affairs, Buchtel Hall 102, by 4 pm on Monday, March 2, 2015. The materials should be contained in a 3-ring binder with labeled tabs for each of the requested sections.

- 1. A current and complete resume/vita
- 2. Supporting material (no more than 20 pages, single-sided) that includes:
  - a. A letter of nomination
  - b. A letter of application—no more than 4 pages in length—responding to the general criteria, highlighting applicant's level of engagement with and **verified** impact on public and/or community organizations in addressing critical community concerns, and evidence of student learning
  - c. A letter of support from the community members with which the nominee has been **substantially** involved
  - d. A complete list of activities or projects with which the nominee has been substantially involved
  - e. Other forms of verifiable evidence

#### GENERAL CRITERIA

Excellence in community engagement can take many forms. Those submitting materials may want to consider the following perspectives:

# Individuals must have demonstrated excellence in community engagement in one or more of the following areas:

- **Leadership** in working with the public and/or community organizations in addressing critical community concerns, and/or
- · Innovative ways of working for the well-being of citizens and communities, and/or
- Excellence in extending University knowledge
  - Evidence of verified impact on a targeted audience and/or
  - Evidence of verified impact on scholarship/research, instruction and curriculum development, and/or student learning
