## 2015 Outstanding Teacher Award Criteria and Application Process



## THE AWARD

The University of Akron will recognize outstanding achievement in teaching by members of our faculty with the University *Outstanding Teacher Award*. To provide encouragement and incentive for continued excellence in teaching, the 2015 award will include a \$1,500 honorarium.

#### ELIGIBILITY

All full-time University of Akron faculty members currently teaching and employed by the University for at least five years are eligible for consideration for an *Outstanding Teacher Award*. This award requires documented evidence of teaching excellence, as reflected in its impact on student learning and success.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Individuals, who are nominated by their department for this Award should collect, prepare, organize, and submit a portfolio containing the following materials to the Office of Academic Affairs by 4 p.m. on Monday, March 2, 2015. The materials should be contained in a 3-ring binder with labeled tabs for each of the requested sections.

- 1. A current and complete curriculum vitae
- 2. Supporting material (no more than 20 pages, single-sided), that includes:
  - a. A letter of nomination from the department chair or school director or supervisor (no more than three pages long, double-spaced)
  - b. A letter of application -- no more than 4 pages in length responding to the general criteria, highlighting applicant's level of engagement with **verified** impact on students, through teaching
  - c. Student/colleague testimonials and letters of support no more than 5, total that focus on applicant's course(s) at UA
  - d. A summary of the applicant's student evaluations from courses taught at UA- limit materials to within previous three years
  - e. Other forms of **verifiable** evidence or artifacts collected within the past three years, which support the application such as descriptions of student projects or assignments with which the nominee has been **substantially** involved, grading rubrics, evidence of campus involvement, or student mentoring

## GENERAL CRITERIA

Excellence in teaching and scholarship can take many forms. Those submitting materials may want to consider the following perspectives:

# An Outstanding University of Akron Teacher must demonstrate exceptional:

- **Knowledge/Preparation** Deep and comprehensive knowledge of his/her discipline or field and a commitment to remaining current in course-related preparation
- Instructional Design Skills Skill in defining appropriate learning goals, outcomes, and standards; and in developing challenging assignments and assessments consistent with those course goals and outcomes
- Teaching Skills Skill in communicating course material clearly and effectively to a wide range
  of UA students; and skill in promoting deep learning (not just rote memorization), including critical
  and creative thinking
- **Motivational Skills** Skill in promoting appreciation of the subject matter and interest in further learning
- Creativity Ability to adapt/develop new instructional solutions to the ever-changing learning needs and characteristics of UA students
- **Learner-Centeredness** Skill in helping UA students discover and achieve their individual educational goals
