2015 Award to Recognize Contract Professionals/Staff Instrumental in Student Success Criteria and Application Process

THE AWARD

The University of Akron recognizes exceptional achievement in the dedication to student academic support, student learning, and student engagement with the Award to Recognize Contract Professionals/Staff Instrumental in Student Success. The award will include an honorarium of \$1,500.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Individuals, who are nominated by their department for this award should collect, prepare, organize, and submit a portfolio containing the following materials to the Office of Academic Affairs, Buchtel Hall 102 by 4 p.m. on Monday, March 2, 2015. The materials should be contained in a 3-ring binder with labeled tabs for each of the requested sections.

- 1. A current and complete resume
- 2. Supporting material (no more than 20 pages, single-sided), that includes:
 - a. A letter of nomination from the director or supervisor
 - b. A letter of application—no more than 4 pages in length—responding to the general criteria, highlighting applicant's level of engagement with **verified** impact on students related to student success
 - c. Student/colleague testimonials and letter of support—no more than 5, total—that focus on the applicant's engagement with students
 - d. A complete list of activities with which the nominee has been substantially involved
 - e. Other forms of **verifiable** evidence or artifacts collected within the past three years, which support the application such as evidence of campus and community involvement, student mentoring, serving on division- or university-wide committees

General Criteria

Excellence in student success can take many forms. Those submitting materials may want to consider the following perspectives:

Contract Professionals/Staff who are Instrumental in Student Success must have demonstrated exceptional:

- **Dedication** to students' academic success and engagement in the campus community
- **Commitment** to enhancing support for student success, particularly through creating and supporting "The Akron Experience"
- Skill in promoting the appreciation of what it takes to be successful in college
- Ability to adapt/develop new solutions to the ever-changing needs and characteristics of UA students
- **Commitment** to helping UA students discover and achieve their individual educational goals
