

In Fall 2017, the Office of Academic Affairs approved the revival of the Institute for Teaching and Learning, which had been defunct for several years. The revival was led by Janet Bean (Coordinator of General Education), Michelle Byrne (Director of Assessment), Aimée deChambeau (Dean of University Libraries), and Wendy Lampner (Director of Design and Development Services).

The University of Akron's Institute for Teaching and Learning's mission is to support faculty by focusing on improving teaching and enhancing student learning. We offer workshops, information sessions, and training related to professional development, general education, student learning assessment, course design and development, and implementation of technology to enhance teaching.

The goals for ITL in its first year of revival were to:

- 1. Promote faculty development and improved teaching in through a centralized, well-known, and respected unit on campus.
- 2. Cross-pollinate professional development initiatives, particularly those related to academic program assessment, general education, Design and Development Services, and University Libraries.
- 3. Allow for centralized promotion, scheduling, and registration for professional development events.
- 4. Document faculty professional development activities for faculty use (merit, RTP, NTT Evaluation) and institutional use (HLC accreditation).
