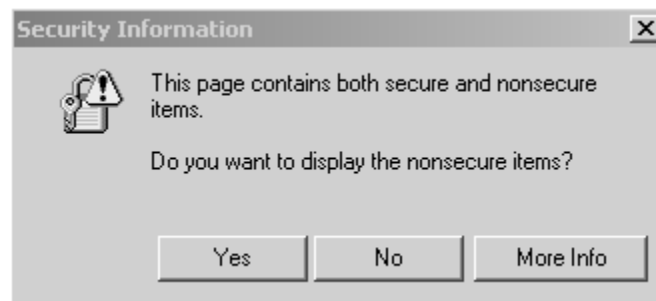



Eliminating the Secure/Nonsecure Warning Messages in Internet Explorer 7

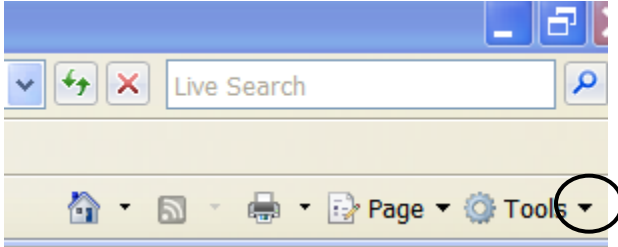
This document provides instructions on modifying an option in Internet Explorer in order to eliminate the mixed content warning messages. Below is a sample of the mixed content warning message.

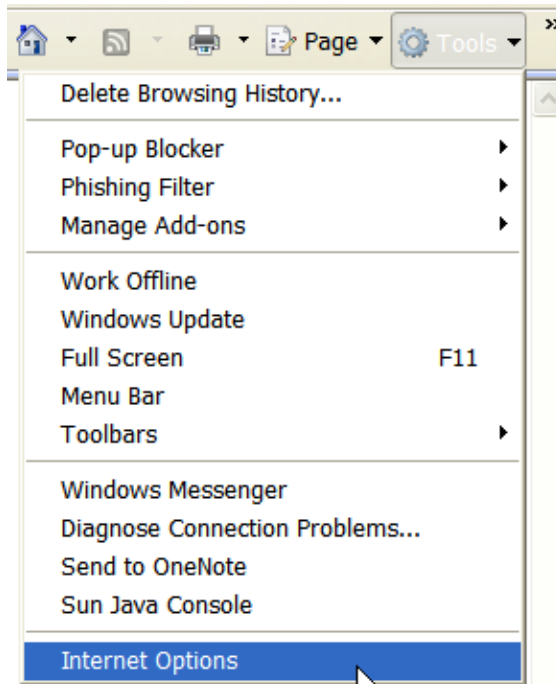


Instructions:

1. After you open Internet Explorer, click the arrow to the right of the  button.

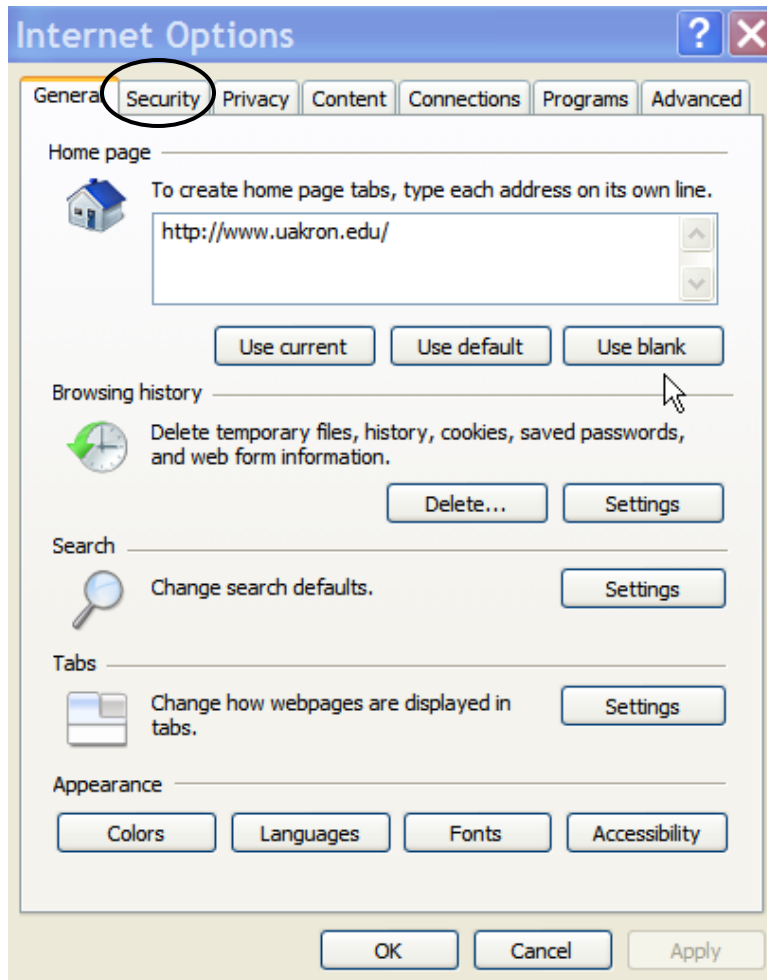


2. Select **Internet Options** from the list of choices.



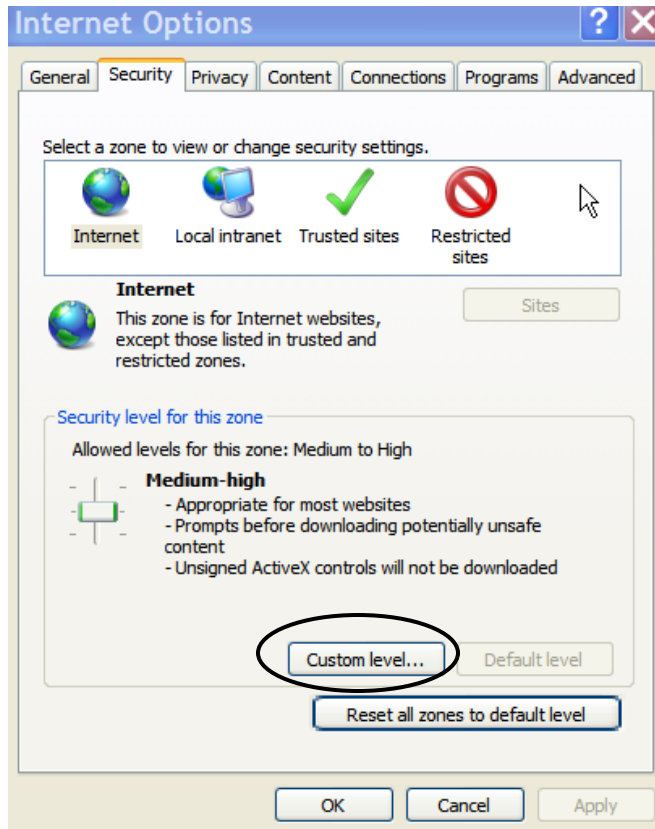

3. The Internet Options dialog box displays. Click the **Security** tab.



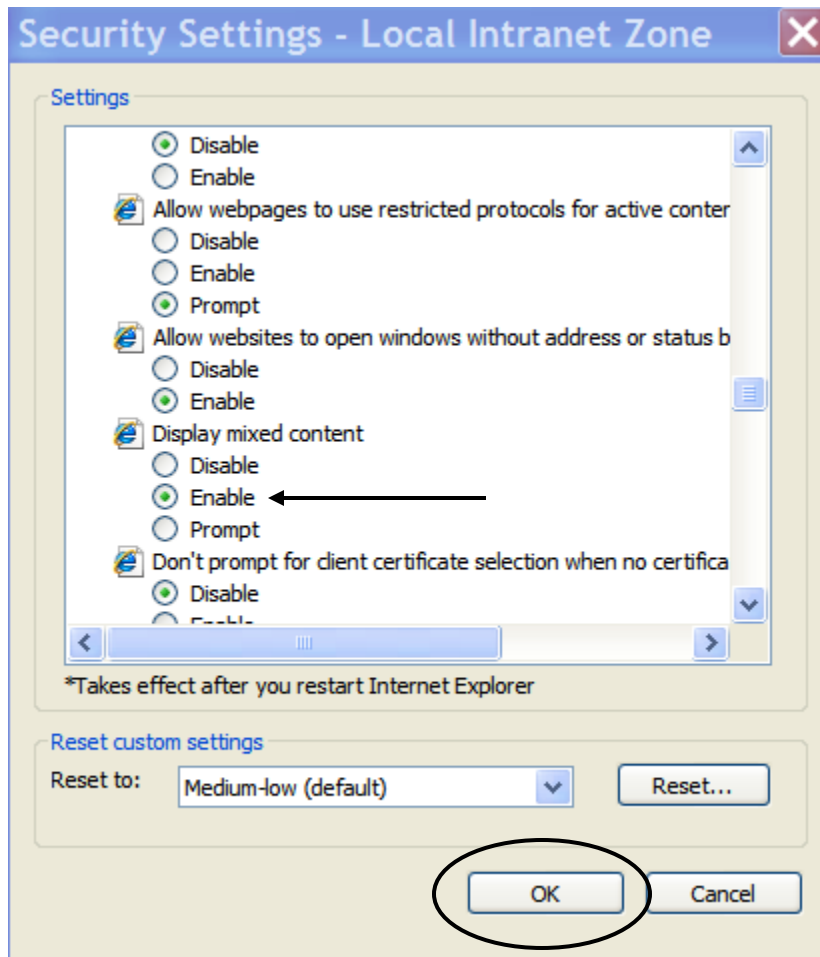

4. Click the **Custom level...** button.

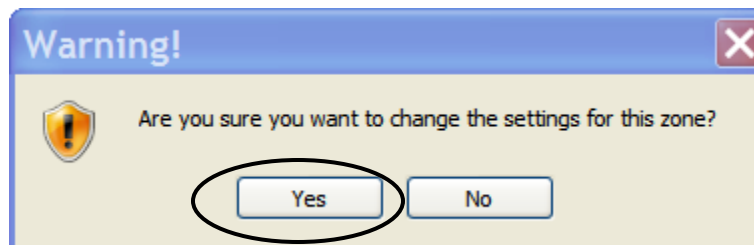

5. Select the **Enable** radio button under the “**Display mixed content**” setting. Click the **OK** button to save this setting.

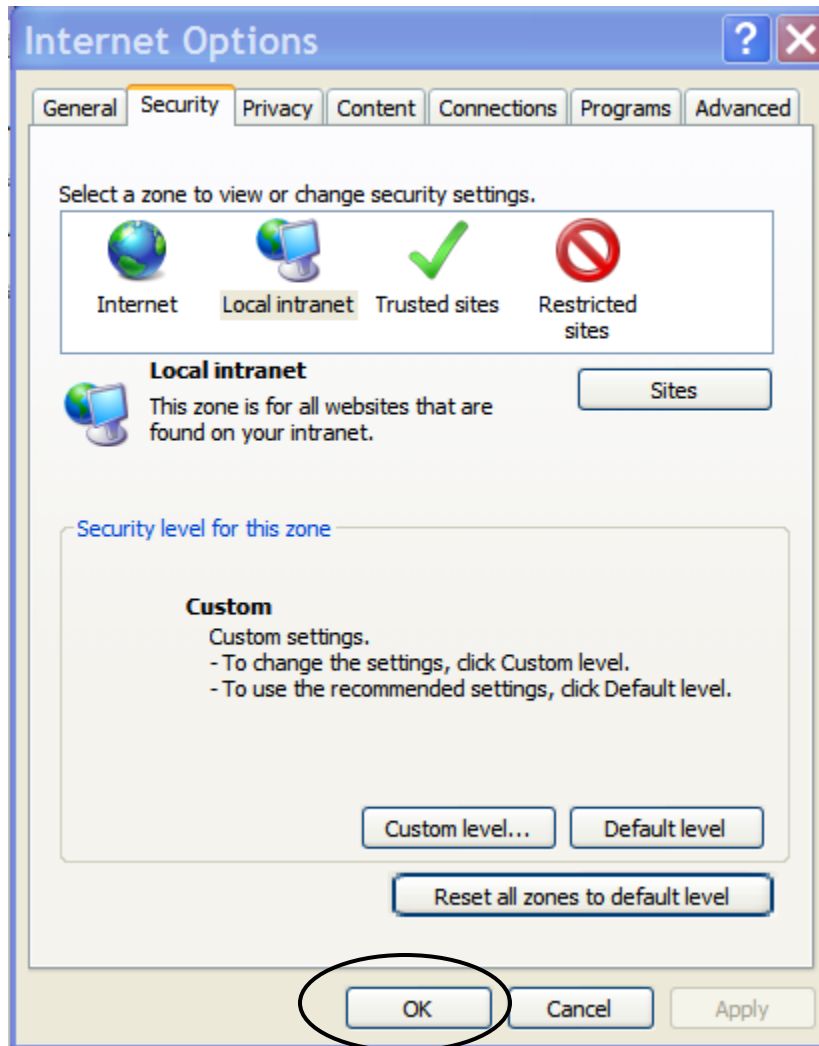


6. You will be prompted to make sure you wish to accept this change. Click “**Yes**” to accept this change.
