GRAND TOTAL = 88 credits to graduate with Juris Doctor Degree

(or 91 will be required depending on academic performance)

**In order to enhance prospects for academic success, some first year students will take a special academic skills course, Criminal Law Lab (CLL), in the spring semester instead of Legal Research and Writing II. Students with a GPA of 2.30 and lower at the end of the first semester will be required to take CLL. And many other students with GPA's above 2.30 choose to take the course in order to enhance academic skills. Absent extenuating circumstances, all CLL students with 2.30 and lower GPA end fall semester of first year will be required to take Legal, Research, and Writing II during the summer after the first year.

***Students who are required to enroll in the Criminal Law Lab course in the spring semester shall be required to take LARW II in the subsequent summer semester unless excused from enrollment by the Dean due to extraordinary circumstances. A student thus required to take LARW II in the summer may not be employed during that time if the student also enrolls in any other course while enrolled in the summer LARW II course.
