Amendment to Application for Admission**

As you know, when you applied for admission, you signed off a statement which includes the following:

"...I acknowledge that I have a continuing duty to inform the School of Law as to any relevant information or change in circumstances that relates to any of these questions of which I became aware after the date of my signature below."

Bar clearance questions are a part of the law school application. Effective March 8, 2006, the bolded, underlined language was added to Question #2 below. Under ABA standards, you are required to update your admission accordingly.

The following bar clearance questions are part of the law school application:

Check "No" or "Yes" to the following questions. Please explain each "Yes" response according to the guidelines listed below. We strongly recommend that you submit this documentation in an attached document in order for your application to be processed in a timely fashion, and a decision on your application returned more quickly.

- No Yes 1. Have you ever been arrested (even if the arrest record was expunged)?
- No Yes 2. Have you ever been charged with and/or convicted of any criminal offense, **including any traffic violations, parking tickets, etc.**? Disclose any matters that may have been expunged.
- No Yes 3. Have you ever had any license denied, suspended, or revoked?
- No Yes 4. Have you ever been on probation, suspended, dismissed, or been the subject of disciplinary action by any school for any reason other than grade deficiency?
- No Yes 5. Have you ever been discharged or asked to resign from employment?

If you checked "Yes" to any of the above questions, please include **SPECIFIC** information that includes the following:

- Date of incident and your age at the time of the incident
- Parties involved
- Description of incident
- Result (expunged, dismissed, probation, arrest, incarceration, etc.)
- Degree of misdemeanor or felony and code section (Ohio Revised Code or other state or city code involved)
- Photocopy of official court documentation, if applicable
- Information related to post-sentence events (pardon, etc.)

Vague statements are **NOT** acceptable. Failure to fully disclose may result in dismissal from the School of Law.

If an amendment is needed, you must complete this form, attach any explanatory documentation, and submit to Law Student Services in the Dean's Office, Room 136.
