Up to 12 credits of IP coursework completed at the J.D. level with a grade of "B" or higher at THE UNIVERSITY OF AKRON SCHOOL OF LAW within the past three years ONLY FOR THOSE WHO ALSO HAVE AKRON'S IP CERTIFICATE may be applied to these 30 credits.

Approval must be obtained in advance from the Director of the IP Center, and is dependent upon the quality of the student's previous academic performance as well as the content of the coursework taken.
