Reminders

- All financial obligations to The University of Akron must be reconciled prior to degree candidacy (i.e., name in the commencement program, ceremony participation and degree conferral).
- ♦ Ceremony Honors and Honors Regalia: Honors announced at the commencement ceremony are determined by your honors grade point average (GPA) at the end of the tenth week of spring 2017. Your honors GPA calculation includes ALL graded courses, including allowably repeated and reassessed courses. Honors medallions (baccalaureate degrees) and cords (associate degrees) are distributed during commencement ceremony quest ticket distribution.
