### **Field Learners**

- Graduate Foundation Learners (Learners beginning their *first* field placement)
  - o 200 hours per Semester | 400 hours Academic Year
  - o 16 Hours per week
- Graduate Concentration Students (Advanced Standing learners-first placement or learners beginning their second field placement)
  - o 250 hours per Semester | 500 hours Academic Year
  - 17 Hours per week
- Familiarity with competencies | Clarity on Result: engage, assess, intervene, evaluate

### **Field Requirements**

- Two consecutive semesters | In the same agency
- Fall Semester August 28, 2017 December 10, 2017
  - Foundation students begin their field experience week of September 11<sup>th</sup>- two weeks into the semester, yet end at the same time as concentration students
  - o Concentration students begin their field experience
  - Final Exams Week December 11-17, 2017
- Spring Semester January 16, 2018 May 6, 2018
  - Foundation & Concentration students begin their field experience at the same time | when the semester begins- week of January 16<sup>th</sup>
  - o Spring break is Monday, March 26, 2018- Sunday, April 1, 2018
  - Final Exams Week May 7-13, 2018
- MSW students are required to make up all missed field education time | program meets the CSWE minimum standard of required field hours
  - Grading Method = Pass/Fail (Credit/No Credit)
  - o Four Hour blocks of field minimum

# **Professional Development**

- Field Instructor (Agency-based)
  - Primary field learning source
  - Orientation to agency and personnel
  - o Assist in developing the Student Integrative Learning Contract
  - o Provide required weekly face-to-face supervision (minimum of one hour)
  - Assign appropriate tasks with gradual increase in responsibility and complexity
  - Provide on-going evaluation of student progress
  - Help learners transfer and integrate classroom knowledge into practical application (signature pedagogy)
- Faculty Liaisons (*University-based*)
  - Assigned faculty member serves as the university's representative to the student and support for the agency
  - o Overall responsibility for quality assurance of the field experience
  - Ensure that the field education objectives are being met
  - Assist the field instructor and student in achieving the objectives
  - o One required site visit per semester

## **Problem Resolution Procedures**

- Refer to MSW Field Manual
- Remember- you are part of a <u>team</u> that view problems as teaching/learning opportunities
- Be proactive and practice problem resolution with field instructor first, if unsuccessful, contact field faculty liaison, continued lack of success- immediately contact field contact person
- No changes of assigned field placement without meeting with your assigned field contact person
