SURVEY OVERVIEW

- Conducted November 19, 2015 to December 11, 2015
- Made available to all faculty, staff and students
 - Emailed to 28,142 individuals
 - Reminders posted in The Digest and ZipMail
 - Total surveys started: 6,598
 - Total surveys finished: 5,618
 - Completion rate: 19.96%
- Respondent demographics:
