Purpose

The Association of The University of Akron Retirees (AUAR), a recognized campus organization, brings together retirees of the university for advocacy, service and educational, cultural and social activities:

- Service activities are designed to provide opportunities for members to assist The University of Akron and the larger Akron community.
- Educational, cultural and social activities have included monthly luncheons featuring campus and Akron area speakers, theater events, annual Lobster and Suds social, chili/soup suppers, sports events and bus trips to places of interest.

History

In May 1998, The Faculty Senate of The University of Akron approved a proposal calling for the creation of the Emeriti College. The following month the University's Board of Trustees gave its approval, and the Association of The University of Akron Retirees (AUAR) was established. The AUAR was originally housed in the Institute for Life-Span Development and Gerontology and in 2003 was moved to Human Resources. AUAR is affiliated with the Ohio Association of College and Higher Education Retirees (OCHER).

Membership

Membership is open to all retirees from The University of Akron, both Akron and Wayne campuses. Associate membership is available to spouses of deceased retirees and persons who retired from any state retirement system or approved alternative retirement system, who had at least 5 years of full-time service with the University of Akron. Membership year runs from July 1st through June 30th.
