





How much confidence do you have that your vote will be counted fairly in the November 2020 election?




Top Five Concerns about Voting

% Very or Some Concern




Next Five Concerns about Voting

% Very or Some Concern




Do you support, oppose or have no opinion on Ohio switching to all mail ballots in 2020?



Correlates of confidence in vote counted fairly

- Mail ballots lost, misplaced -.25
- Electronic breach of vote totals -.22
- Instances of vote fraud -.20
- Registration challenged at the polls -.12
- Unable to obtain mail ballot -.10
- Finding/getting to polling place -.09
- Efforts to discourage voting -.08

- **Support all mail voting +.18**

Correlates of race and voting concerns:

- Finding/getting to polling place -0.23
- Registration challenged at the polls -0.20
- Unable to obtain mail ballot -0.17
- Long lines at polling places -0.08
- Efforts to discourage voting -0.07
- Electronic breach of vote totals -0.07
- COVID hurt election administration -0.07

- **CORRELATIONS OF RACE WITH CONFIDENCE IN FAIR VOTE COUNT AND SUPPORT FOR ALL MAIL BALLOTS ARE NOT STATISTICALLY SIGNIFICANT.**
