Ever since its inception, a strong commitment to excellence in teaching and research has made the University of Delhi a role-model and path-setter for other universities in the country. Its rich academic tradition has always attracted the most talented students many of whom made significant contributions to the society. The Department of Financial Studies (DFS), under the prestigious Delhi University, has been an institution of learning for students who aspire to enhance their managerial efficacy in the finance industry. For the past two decades, DFS has been providing the industry with qualified, proficient and dedicated finance professionals through a full-time two-year Master of Finance and Control (MFC) Programme.

The University of Delhi – South Campus (UDSC) seeks students with skills and interest in Financial Engineering, Financial Economics, Financial Markets, and Financial Derivatives for their internship program with financial institutions in India.

Duration: Ranges from 4-6 weeks. However, students can choose from a short-term (4 to 6 weeks) or long-term (full semester: January-May, or September-January) internship. With long-term internship, students have the option to take courses for credit in UDSC alongside their internship.

To apply: Submit a focused resume that details your analytical, quantitative, and problem solving skills with special focus in above mentioned areas. In a separate page (not exceeding one page), you should clearly and succinctly describe your goals from this internship and expected benefits. Both, your resume and goals should be part of one document. Please email your submissions to both Dr. Chandra (ac10@uakron.edu) and Dr. Kim (ikim1@uakron.edu). In the subject line of your email, you must write “UDSC Internship”.

Things to consider: Winters can be cold in India, but do vary by location. You should be willing to spend the entire duration of the internship in India.

Eligibility: Graduate students, and undergraduate students in their Senior year are eligible to apply. Students must demonstrate strong analytical, quantitative, problem solving, and communication skills. Final decision is at the sole discretion of UDSC and their corporate partners in India.

Potential projects: Students are assigned to projects based on the strategic, sourcing and business requirements of the financial institution as well as on the expertise and aspirations of students, as stated in their résumé.

Support: The organization offering internship may provide basic monthly stipend for the duration of internship. Travel (to and from the US) is student’s responsibility. Local hospitality is afforded by UDSC.

Deadline For January-May positions: October 15
For September-January positions: February 15
