Travel and Lodging

Location: Akron, OH (<u>https://www.visitakron-summit.org/</u>)

Akron, known fondly as the Rubber City, was founded in 1825 on the banks of the Cuyahoga River. Historically, Akron has been a center for manufacturing, serving as the home for companies such as Goodyear, B. F. Goodrich, and Firestone. It is also the birthplace of Alcoholics Anonymous, the site of the oldest airship facility in the world, the site of Sojourner Truth's "Ain't I a Woman" speech, and the home of the Cuyahoga Valley National Park. Today, Akron is home to approximately 200,000 people. It is located approximately 40 minutes south of Cleveland, Ohio and is midway between Chicago and New York.

The University of Akron (UA) (<u>http://www.uakron.edu/about_ua/</u>)

Founded in 1870, The University of Akron is a public research university with 23,100 students from 45 US states and 92 foreign countries. UA offers more than 300 undergraduate and graduate programs. The main campus is located in the city of Akron, with four additional branch campuses. The University is home to the Drs. Nicholas and Dorothy Cummings Center for the History of Psychology, established in 1965. The Center includes the Archives of the History of American Psychology, the National Museum of Psychology, and the Institute for Human Science and Culture.

Transportation

Airports

Akron Canton Airport

Akron-Canton Airport (CAK) offers nonstop flights to 17 domestic destinations, plus global access aboard six major carriers. It is a short 20 minute drive to The University of Akron campus. Cleveland Hopkins Airport

The Cleveland Hopkins International Airport is the largest commercial airport in Northeast Ohio, serving almost 12 million passengers annually. Shuttles

Quality Shuttle Services 1-888-477-8254

Service available for both CAK and Cleveland Hopkins Airports. Reservations must be received by 5pm EST the day before arrival or sooner. Prices valid 6am to midnight. Ride sharing must be pre-arranged so that all riders are present for the reservation time.

CAK to UA/Hotel:

- \$50/group (tax included; add 15% tip) for 1-3 riders i.e. the total number of riders will split the \$50 cost
- \$75/group (tax included; add 15% tip) for up to 7 riders i.e. the total number of riders will split the \$75 cost

CLE to UA/Hotel:

- \$85/group (tax included; add 15% tip) for 1-3 riders i.e. the total number of riders will split the \$85 cost
- \$150/group (tax included; add 15% tip) for up to 7 riders i.e. the total number of riders will split the \$150 cost

On-Campus Housing

<u>UA Honors Residence Hall</u> – The Honors Residence Hall is a 6-story building with elevator and air-conditioning featuring single or double occupancy options. (Linens and towels included but no toiletries). (\$28/\$41 per night).

Bed and Breakfasts/Vacation Rentals

The <u>O'Neil House</u> is a four-room bed and breakfast located 3.5 miles from the campus. Public transportation is available. Rooms start at \$100/night.

Hotels

For those who prefer to stay off-campus, we have reserved a hotel block of 30 rooms at the <u>Marriott Courtyard Akron Downtown</u>. Go directly to this link to reserve at the Cheiron group rate of \$119/night: <u>https://tinyurl.com/cheironhotel</u>.

The block expires on May 21st so book before then to ensure you receive the conference rate. This hotel is a 20-30 minute walk from the conference site. There is no public transportation. There are several food options in the hotel area.

Other hotel options:

Hilton Garden Inn

\$119/night plus tax. Ask for the University of Akron rate. This hotel is a 5-10 minute drive to the conference. There is a free guest shuttle to the University campus. You will need to arrange that shuttle with the hotel staff when you check in.

Conference Location
