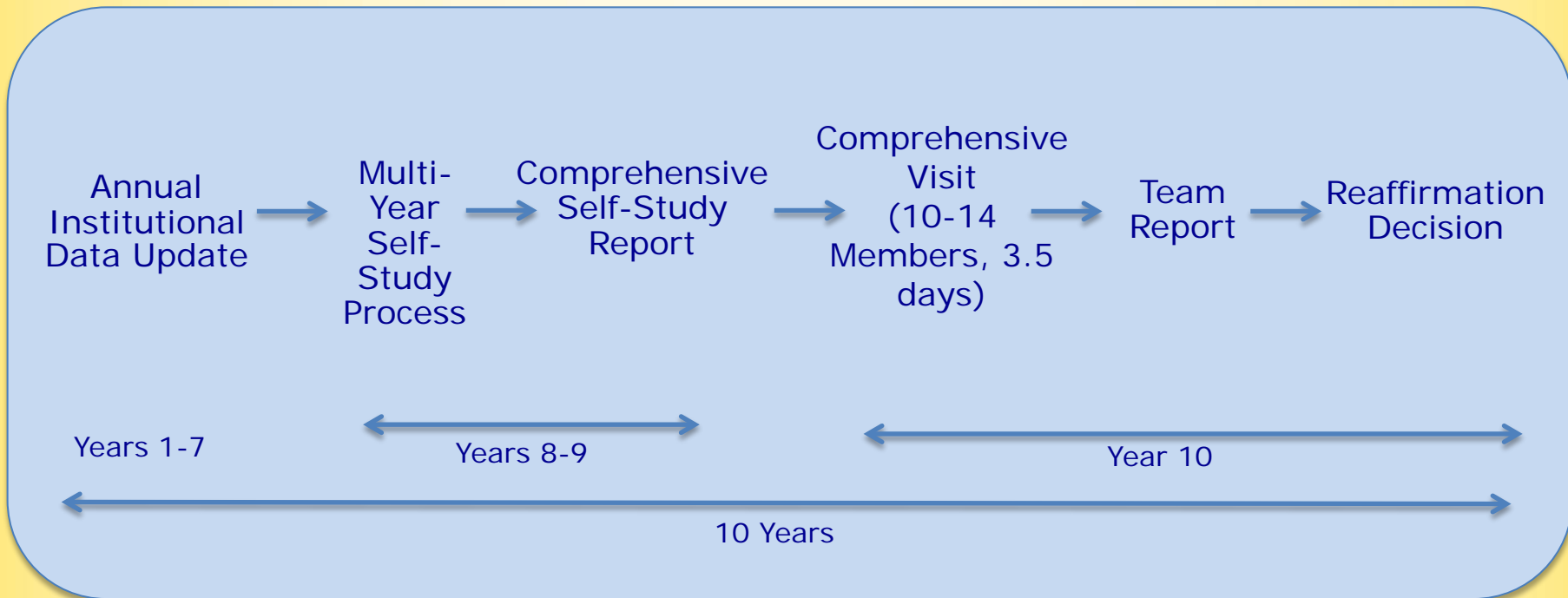
What is HLC?

- Part of NCA
 - 1 of 6 Regional Accrediting Bodies
 - Required for access to federal financial aid
- 1,000+ Institutions
- 19 States
- About 1,500 Peer Reviewer Corps Volunteers
 - Peer Review Corp Advisory Group (8-10 members)
- 47 Staff

- AQIP:
Academic Quality Improvement Program
- Quality Improvement Projects/Checkups
- Other:
Initiation, Candidacy, etc.

- **Fall 2012**

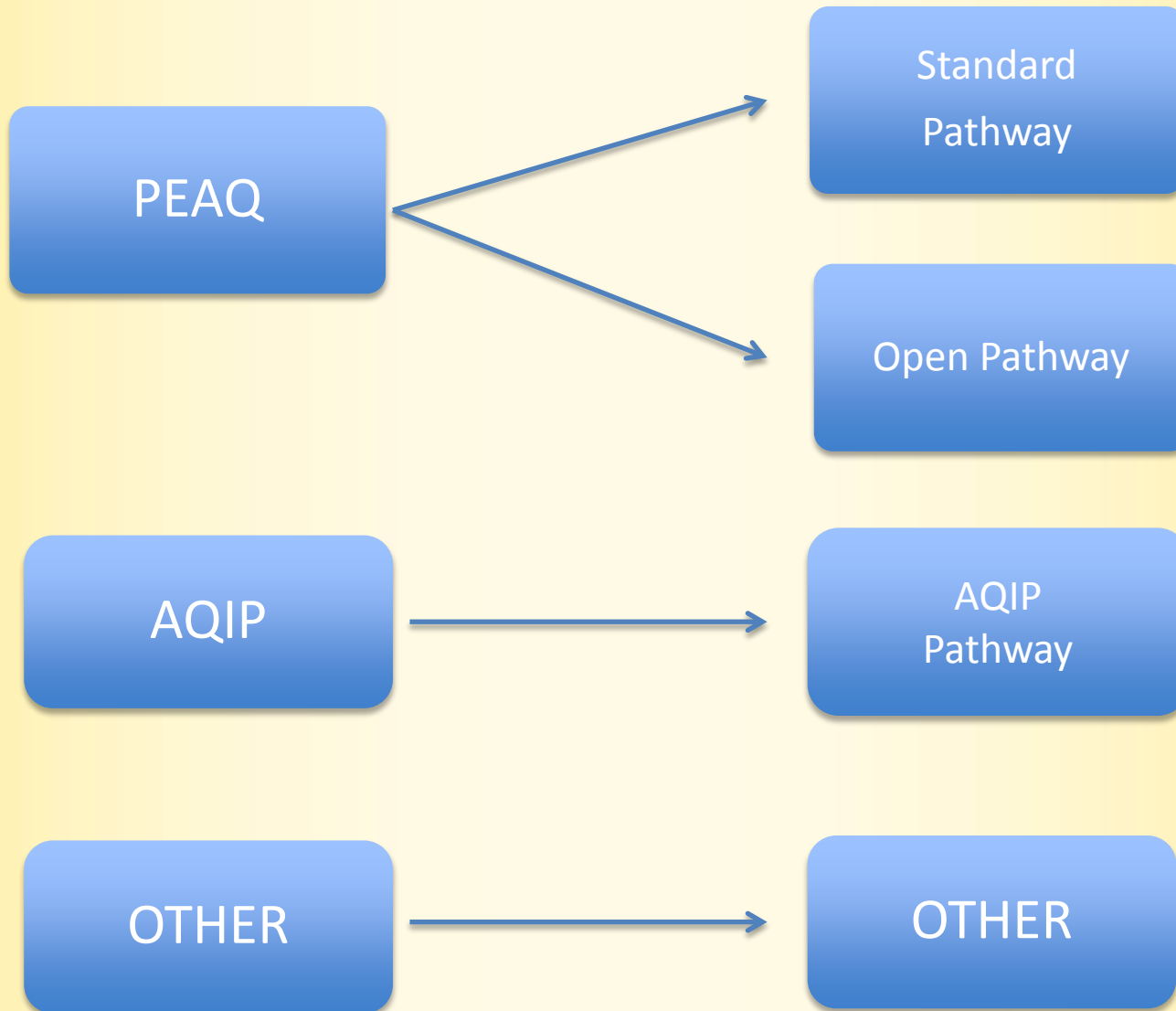
- Finalize self-study report after broad campus input

- **December 2012**

- **Spring 2013**
 - Continue preparing campus for site-visit
- **March 3-6, 2013**
 - Site-visit
 - Board of Trustees members needed
- **Summer 2013**
 - HLC decision on reaffirmation and future processes

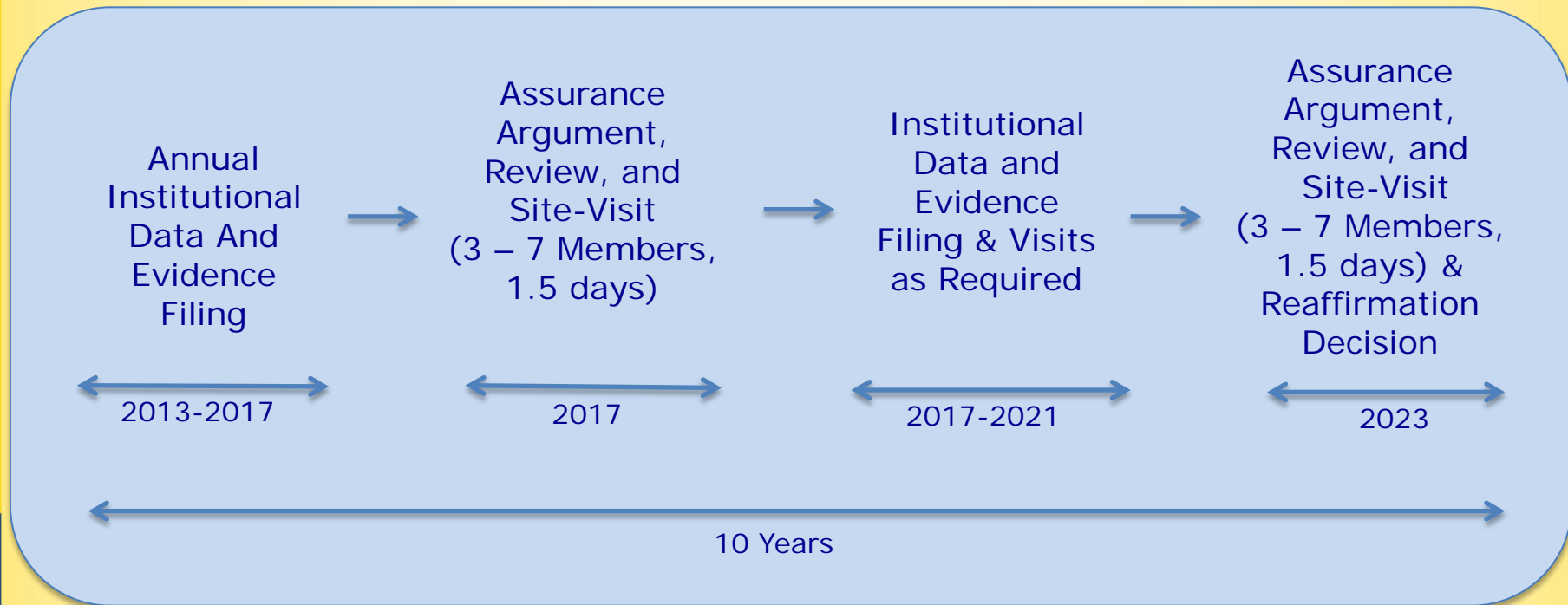
Future HLC Process



Standard Pathway Institutions

- Frequent substantive change approvals
