Determining the Active Standard and the Publication History

To find the active IEEE 1588 standard, use [IEEE Xplore](#). Select **Browse** from the menu, then **Standards** from the dropdown menu. You can search using keywords or by number.

The resulting screen will list the active standard, previous standards, and draft standards. IEEE Xplore provides a publication history of standards. You have to look at the list closely because not all information is what you would expect. Some of the histories can be complicated.

There are several draft standards listed that have not been approved in the results list as well. The draft standards are not available with our subscription.
