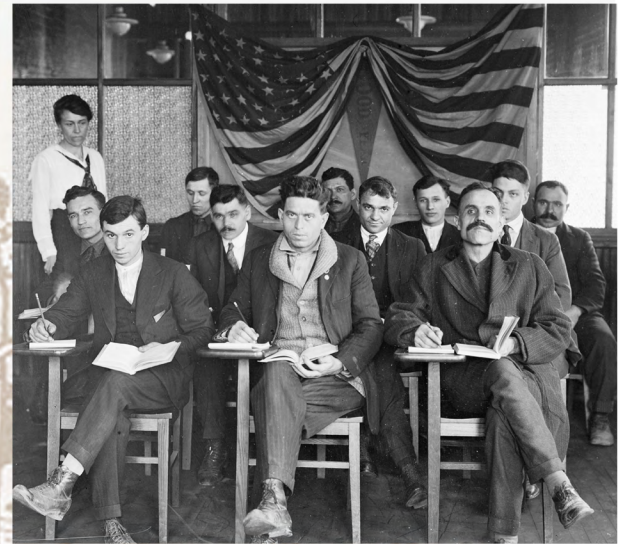
During this workshop, you will learn how to use primary sources, inquiry and community-based strategies to create your own lesson "stem."
