Fall 2016

Total enrollment for Fall 2016 is 23,152 -- a decrease of 8.0% over the previous fall semester

Highlights

Enrollment

- Undergraduate enrollment (by declared major) in The College of Engineering increased 21.6% (n +574) since fall semester 2014
- Professional enrollment in The School of Law increased 2.8% (n +12) over the previous fall semester

Demographics --

• Professional in-state enrollment in The School of Law is up 2.7% (n +9); international enrollment is up 150% (n +3)






Comparison Enrollment By College of Major By Level--Fall Semesters
