Fall 2014

Total enrollment for Fall 2014 is 25,865 -- a decrease of 4.5% over the previous fall semester

Highlights

Enrollment

- Undergraduate enrollment (by declared major) in The College of Engineering increased 5.9% (n +147) over the previous fall semester
- Graduate enrollment (by declared major) increased in the following colleges:
 - College of Business: 5.5% (n +22)
 - College of Engineering: 2.2% (n +9)
 - College of Polymer Science and Polymer Engineering: 7.7% (n +25)

Demographics --

- International enrollment is up 9.0% (n +115)
- Out-of-State enrollment is up 5.5% (n +56)

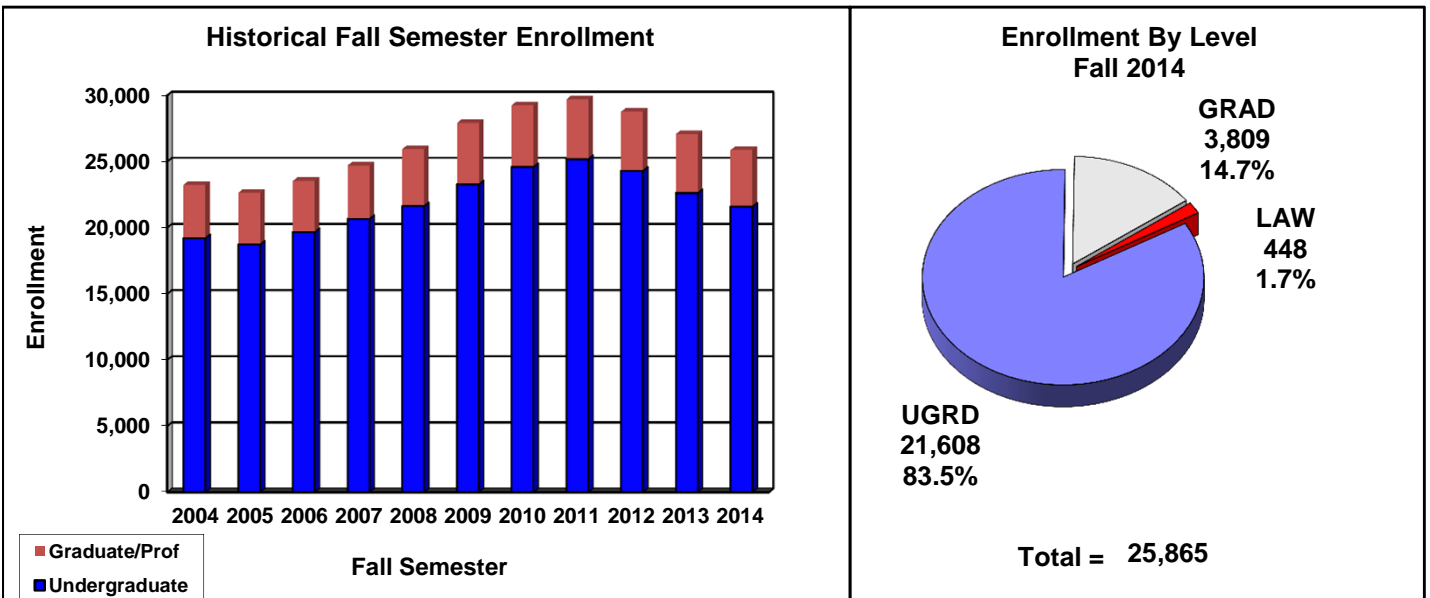

Comparison Enrollment By College of Major By Level--Fall Semesters

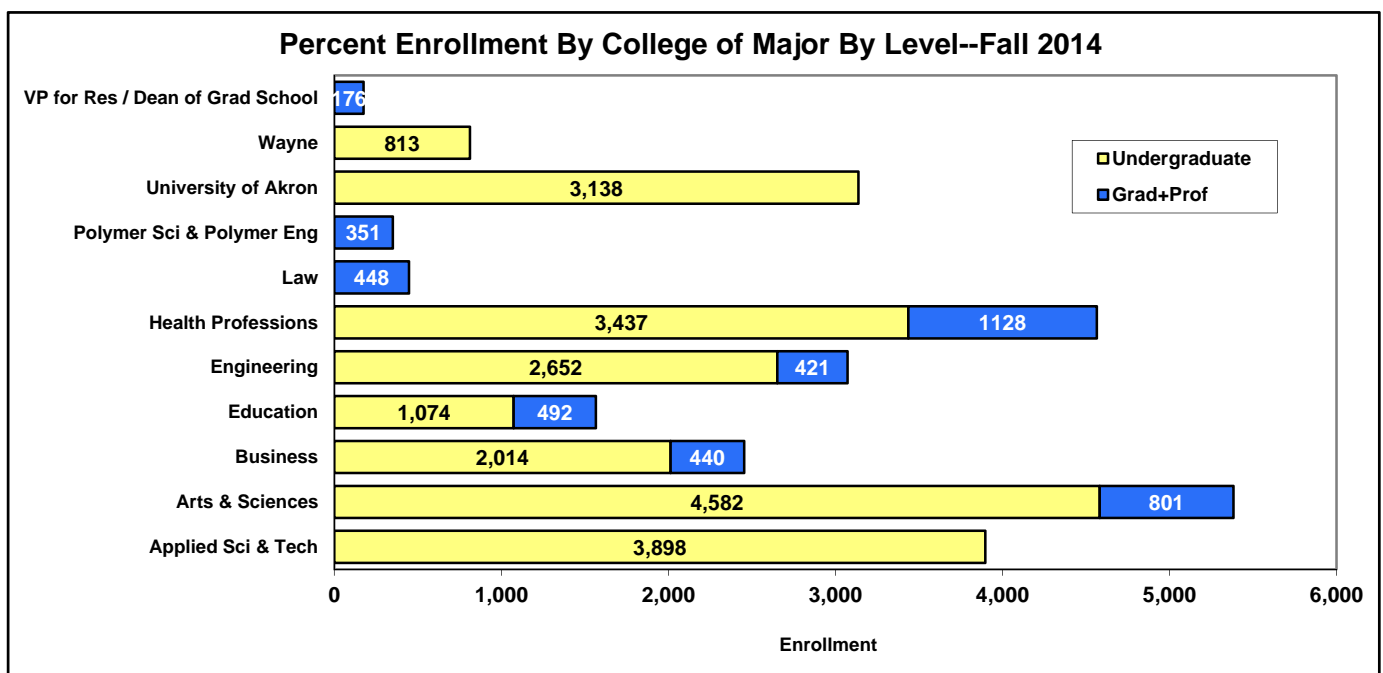
