(FTFTF: First-time, new freshmen, full-time status.

(2) INIT MAJOR:(w. pre-majors) Represents the college of the student's declared major at the time of admission Including pre-majors

(3) "LC" Represents student is enrolled in a living-learning community.

(4) HONORS: Represents students enrolled In the Honors program.

(5) NON HONORS: Represents students enrolled but not In the Honors program.

(6) HS GPA: Student's high school GPA at the time of admission.

(7) ADMIT STATUS: Students admission status (Direct, College Ready, Emergent, Preparatory, and Non,Traditional)

(8) 4 YEAR PROGRAMS: Represents students who are declared bachelor degree seeking at the time of initial enrollment.

(9) UA SP20 GPA: Represents the groupings of the student's GPA at the end of the Spring 2020 semester.

(10) RESIDENT; Represents those students who were Ohio residents at time of admission.

(11) NON RESIDENT: Represents those students who were non-Ohio residents at the time of admission,

(12) HOUSING: Represents the FTFTF who resided in one of UA's residence halls.

(13) PELL ELIGIBLE: Represents those students who are Pell Eligible- according to their FAFSA

(14) FIRST GENERATION: Represents students who indicated their mother and father's highest level of education was elementary or high school - according to their FAFSA.

(15) STEMM Major. Represents students who are declared Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics or Medical majors at the time of initial enrollment.

(16) AKRON PUBLIC SCHOOLS: Represents students who graduated from the Akron Public School System

(17) INIT MAJOR:(no pre-majors) Represents the college of the student's declared major at the time of admission, including pre-majors.
