Please limit attachments to **written statements only** and to a reasonable length, as the Admissions Committee may potentially review more than 2,000 applications in a given application cycle.

### Letters of Recommendation (Optional)

While recommendation letters are optional, the Admissions Committee **STRONGLY SUGGESTS** that applicants have recommenders submit these on their behalf. Letters may be from instructors, employers, colleagues, or others. Letters of recommendation should come from **appropriate sources**. For example, applicants who are currently enrolled in an academic program are strongly encouraged to submit letters from instructors, and applicants who have been out of college for a number of years but have significant work experience should seek letters from employers, colleagues, or clients.

If recommendation letters have not been received, but the application form and personal statement have been received, the admissions committee will review the file. Therefore, applicants are strongly encouraged to ask recommenders to write recommendations and provide them in a sealed, signed envelope so that they may be sent in with the application form or shortly thereafter.
