- FT students must have 29 credit hours completed; PT students must have 20 credit hours completed to be considered.

If you meet the above criteria and are interested in being considered for upper-division scholarships, complete and submit your application, a personal statement, and current resume by5:00 p.m. Friday, April-14, 2023, to the School of Law Dean's Office c/o Assistant Dean Bobbs or via e-mail. If emailing your documents, please save them as one file using the naming convention; lastname.firstname application-resume-personal statement and send to bobbs@uakron.edu. Add "Scholarship Application" to the email subject line.

Scholarship awards will be applied toward fall 2023 and spring 2024 semester tuition only (not summer). 2023 spring start students may apply now and awards for spring start students will be distributed in the spring 2024 semester. Scholarship awards cannot exceed the cost of tuition and fees.
