Total hours taught as of completion of Fall 2021 – 435 hours

Beginning Spanish I & II, University of Akron - 100 hours

-Students are introduced to speaking, listening and writing Spanish. There is a focus of basic oral communication by answering and asking simple questions, the use of scaffolding to develop writing skills and the implementation of a variety of reading strategies that introduce students to various cultural points that tie into the vocabulary and grammar points.

Intermediate Spanish I & II, University of Akron - 189 hours

-Students are building upon strengthening their speaking, listening and writing skills in Spanish at the Intermediate level to have more complicated thoughts and expressions that reflect their personal point of view and opinions on a variety of topics. Writing and reading skills are developed more and reinforce the grammar points taught.

Spanish Conversation, University of Akron - 21 hours

- Students improve their oral expression by means of learning new vocabulary and cultural information, participating in conversations, and the presentation of dialogues. Students also review and practice grammatical points of particular difficulty to further

improve accuracy in oral communication.

Spanish Composition, University of Akron - 9 hours

- Students practice several modes of writing about various topics to develop their written communication skills while learning about cultural phenomena in the Spanish speaking world. Together the class analyzes the elements of a good sentence and paragraph, as well as how to effectively link these units together to build their proficiency. This also includes reviewing some more advanced linguistic structures and working to improve the accuracy of their interpersonal and presentational written communication.

ST: The Ugly American, University of Akron – 4 hours

- Students who will be studying abroad in the DISSTA Summer Study Abroad Program in Valladolid, Spain prepare for their experience through readings, videos, lectures and discussions. The focus is essential information on the customs, values, traditions and behaviors in Spain and how to adjust to life overseas. Through a variety of resources the stereotypes of Americans abroad will be analyzed and discussed. The students are taught about the importance of being culturally respectful and learn how to avoid the perpetuation of this stereotype by developing a cross-cultural understanding.

Beginning Spanish I & II, University of Mount Union – 112 hours

-Students work to develop a functional command at the novice level by asking and answering simple questions, writing sentences to prompts and improving their reading strategies to understand cultural readings. Differences in culture and then compared and contrasted. There is also a focus on associating historical, geographical and cultural facts to the respective country and improving their knowledge on these subjects in relation to Spanish speaking countries.
