# Progression to Major Application Process

## Disclosure Statement

- I request consideration for entry into the ADN nursing major for Spring 2026.
- To be **eligible** for consideration into the Nursing major I must:
  - 1) Have completed or be currently completing **all** required prerequisite coursework by the end of the Fall 2025 Semester.
  - 2) Have maintained a grade of “C” or better in each required prerequisite course.
  - 3) Have a 2.5 **Prerequisite** G.P.A. or higher.
  - 4) Hold a current CNA certification, attend the CNA boot camp at University of Akron, or complete a patient care assistance course approved by the director.
  - 5) Passing score of HESI (75% on reading and math exams), ACT minimum 22/ SAT minimum 1030 and GPA of 2.75 on previous college coursework, or grade of C in any college math and English/psychology/or sociology. (The HESI requirement is waived if you have an associate degree or higher in another field.)
- Entry is not guaranteed and ranking of applicants is based on the prerequisite GPA. If a science course has been repeated, the applicant will be placed in the second admission category. No preadmission course can be repeated more than one time.
- Acceptances will be sent out by January 1 after student applications have been reviewed.
- If I am awarded a seat to enter the major, I am required to attend **Nursing Orientation – TBD**.
- I will not be able to enroll in any nursing courses (NURS) until after orientation.
- I need to enroll in the required co-requisite courses\* and any other desired course as soon as my Spring 2026 enrollment period begins. I should block out times that potential nursing courses are offered to avoid schedule conflicts if awarded a seat to begin the nursing major Spring 2026.

\*Co-requisite nursing courses include: BIOL 202 Human A&P II or ANAT 207 Applied A&P II and BIOL 203 Human A&P II Lab or ANAT 211 Applied A&P II lab – these all require a C or better with no more than one attempt.
- If I am completing any prerequisite course at another institution as a Transient student, I am required to contact my advisor no later than October 30th.
- If offered a seat in the nursing major, I will be required to affirm that no record of any type will be found in my background check. This includes misdemeanors and felonies which I may think have been expunged or sealed.
- I will read the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Academic Policies & Procedures Handbook.
- If my plans change, I will notify my adviser immediately.
