## 1) Open Meeting

- a) Suzanne Testerman opened the meeting at 3:08PM
- b) Meeting Minutes of July 28, 2014 were distributed and reviewed for edits. Myra Weakland noted that she was absent with notice. That change will be incorporated into the minutes. There being no additional edits, the meeting minutes were approved with stated modification.

### 2) New Business

- a) <u>Time Capture Central Hower</u>
  - i) CPAC List-Serv received a message from a CP in the College of Education expressing concerns over the requirement for signing in and out of the Central Hower space. The committee discussed the concern and Mike Szczukowski will discuss the issue with Dean Clark and report the results at the September meeting.

- c) Enrollment Status Update Diane Raybuck
  - President Scarborough reported on current enrollment trends just prior to CPAC meeting.
    Diane reiterated those successes as follows:
    - (1) Overall freshman enrollment is up 2% with nearly 4,300 students currently registered
    - (2) Among first-time freshmen on main campus pursuing a bachelor's degree, enrollment is up 9.4%, and the average GPA -- the best predictor of college success -- is again up slightly from the year before, from 3.33 to now 3.35, the highest in UA's history.
    - (3) Our Honors College is seeing record enrollment, with nearly 600 new freshmen students (compared to 347 last year) with overall enrollment in Honors of 1,828, a record for UA.
  - ii) A discussion of a change around the cancellation of classes for non-payment noted that those students who have financial aid in progress would not be dropped until 09/02.
