Meeting commenced at approximately 3:10 PM.

The SEAC Executive Committee met with President Proenza to introduce him to the newly elected members. We introduced ourselves to Dr. Proenza and talked a little about where we work on campus and what we do.

President Proenza started out reiterating SEAC's roll on campus to promote staff well-being and communicate staff issues to the President in order to promote improvement of campus relationships. Dr. Proenza also reminded us that we can ask UA participants to direct funds back to UA in the United Way campaign. UA measures success of the United Way campaign not only via donated dollars, but also returned pledge cards, whether there is money donated or not. We can encourage staff to return their pledge cards.

It was decided through discussion that we should try to meet with the President at least quarterly, but occasionally we may need to resort to email meetings if the president has a busy travel schedule. We should always carbon copy Chris Zacharias in his office so she can follow up for us.
