Help the families to adjust on an ongoing basis, until they become self-sufficient
- Liaison for outside organizations with inquiries about refugee families, or the department in general. Mostly including medical offices, ODJFS, and the public-school systems
- Supervise interns; provide support and consultation for other case managers
