Financial Aid FYI:

- Complete FAFSA (fafsa.gov) Akron's Code is 003123
 - If taxes were filed electronically then complete the FAFSA online
 - If taxes were not filed electronically still complete the application and provide the information on the next steps
 - Review SAR report
 - If needed, Apply for a federal PIN (Personal Identification number)
 - Review Master Institutional Aid Application
 - You may have to go through Verification
 - Review your MY Akron for accepting and declining awards
 - Check Status of your aid
 - Review refund policy
 - Review how to keep your aid
