This is a typical construction process. Steve shared some potential design pictures of the project. Trying to move phase 1 up to move people/areas out of older buildings and consolidate them to Polsky's. Some areas moving out of buildings and into Polsky's are Lincoln building, Administrative Services building, School of Counseling in the Chima building over by Exchange St.; and the School of Counseling which works with Audiology. There will also be 170 stations for esports. There are plans to renovate the attached, existing Polsky parking deck.
