General Updates from Stephen Myers

- Finally received the \$1M grant reimbursement for the tear down of the Wonder Bread building.
- The ASB parking desk is now closed to pedestrian parking as well. The plan is to move everyone on the first floor of the ASB into the Polsky building.
- Grounds was moved into Central Hower.
- Corridor refresh in Olin Hall.
- Working with Student Services and Student Wellness Center to create a mental health oasis in Simmons Hall.
- Dunkin construction work in Student Union will take place over summer.
- Hardscape project is moving along. The Monday after commencement, the project will be moved to the center of campus. There may be a little overlap of the fences.
- Bid is out right now for the safety issues with the VAC system in the Daum theater in Kolbe Hall. Still able to use the theater as long as the occupancy is low but for any events, a fire marshal is needed to be hired.
- Cooling tower #1 is moving along as well as the next phase of the camera surveillance project (although at a reduced scope because of the amount.)
- Buckingham elevator's work is complete but waiting on inspection and certification. Leigh Hall's elevator is about 15-20% completed and the elevator in PFOc is only about 5% completed. Polsky's elevators are about 7% completed.
- Repair on the line between Honors and the vault next to the Martin Garden will be consolidated into the common landscape project. The Olson vault is going to be bid out separately.
- Trying to figure out a way to reroute some electrical infrastructure that's underneath the street at University and Hill.
- Transformers that have been on hold for 16 months are supposed to get here in May so there will probably be some shutdowns over the Summer.
- Small project at the Polsky parking deck to take care of some structural issues and outside beautification. Polsky's deck is not part of the concession and is UA's responsibility.
- Robertson's water heater is currently being installed.
- Knight Center for Creative Engagement is going along well. Close to the end of the schematic design. The schematic design package is due on the April 25 which will go to the construction pricing manager. Spent a year in conceptual design, now almost through schematic design, then goes to development and construction documents and then actual construction.
- Final documentation to sell Quaker Square is coming up and should be able to close within 3 or 4 weeks.
- The Medina commissioners finally approved the signing of the Medina property. The documents will then go down to Columbus for approval.
- Martin Center and Central Hower are still on the market with only a few inquiries.
- Repatching the roof in Shrank. There's also an elevator issue on the North side that will eventually be addressed.

Announcements/Good of the Order

- A transfer switch needs to be replaced and some 20 buildings on campus will be without power the week of May 12. More details will be forthcoming in the Digest.
