New Business • A motion was made by Melissa, seconded by Becky, to move the discussion on the survey portion of our goal (2.1) to later in the fiscal year when we have confirmed members. • Physical Facilities Operations Center sent out an email encouraging people to participate in a survey. A drawing for a tour of the rooftops or tunnels is offered as an incentive for taking the survey. General Updates from Stephen Myers • Quaker Square—Sale has closed and UA no longer owns it. However, there is a deal that Aramark can still use the facilities until July, 2026. • Medina campus—should be closing by end of the month. • Martin Center—there has been an offer. Hopefully, approval can be given by Columbus before Steve leaves. • Lincoln Bldg—Working to get some HUD (\$700,000-\$800,000 funding to demo. An environmental review needs to be completed to get the funding released which had been allotted in a bill a while ago. Jim Haskel will be facilitating getting the funds. • Central Hower—Renovation change work order is still under construction. • Olin Hall—Received numbers but not sure moving forward as the number were quite high. • Football offices—Project to clean up some work from a non-related fire that set off the sprinkler system is completed. But furniture not received yet. • Dunkin Donuts—It will be a tight deadline to get it open before the semester starts. • Buchtel Commons—behind schedule about 3 weeks. Completion is expected for Fall 2026. • Colby hall—Need to repair the smoke hatch system in the top of the stage area. But because it's a relatively small job, haven't received any bids. • Cooling tower—Bids have come in but may go back and do a change order to get one that will last 40-50 years. • Knight chemical storage—Sent out rebid and accepted one. • Robertson water heater—has been installed. • Polymer innovation cluster. Chamber of commerce has chosen the Lincoln building site as their new location for their new polymer facility. Working through the logistics on what that looks like. Possibility of tearing down and rebuilding. It will be offices to support that facility but not owned or operated by UA. However, it will be closely affiliated with us. Most everyone in the Lincoln building will be moving to Polsky (budgeting, Steve's office, UA press) except for Safety. Safety will be in a semi-permanent home until the operations building is built. • Shrank—Roof has not been replaced, but have done some patching work and, so far, not much water infiltration at this point. Proposals to do the elevators have been completed but Administration wants to figure out what they want to do with the building before putting in \$1M for the elevators. • Elevator modernization—Buckingham and Leigh Hall elevators are complete. However, an agreement with the service provider for monitoring services (of newly installed elevators) is going through legal. Work on the PFOC and Polky's elevators are still being done.
