The committee outlined several priorities for the upcoming year, emphasizing the integration of academics and athletics, planning the annual RooFit event, and expanding community-building initiatives. Athletics was identified as a powerful tool to support enrollment, foster campus pride, and provide opportunities for faculty research and student engagement. The committee also discussed creating a "Ziptastic Wellness Award" to recognize contributions to wellness in mental, physical, and financial health, though challenges with implementation were noted. Alternatives such as spotlighting student-athletes who volunteer were suggested to promote recognition and boost morale.

Additional goals included strengthening community connections through activities like book clubs, walking groups, and better use of shared spaces, as well as improving branding to reinforce university identity and pride. Strategies such as producing short storytelling videos were proposed to highlight achievements and unify the campus under a consistent message. The committee also stressed the importance of bridging the main and Wayne College campuses through intentional leadership and collaboration. Overall, athletics was seen as a unifying force with the potential to enhance pride, morale, and engagement across the university community.
