MSEE Coursework Policies (Thesis Option)

The MSEE degree requires 24 credits of graduate coursework.

ECE courses (4400, 4450): 15 credits

-- Any graduate ECE course is allowed.

Mathematics (3450): 3 credits

-- The following math courses are **NOT** allowed:

3450:501	History of Mathematics
3450:520	Mathematical Technology and Communication
3450:591	Workshop in Mathematics
3450:692	Seminar in Mathematics
3450:695	Practicum in Mathematics
3450:697	Individual Reading

Approved Electives: 6 credits

-- Any graduate engineering course (4200, 4250, 4300, 4400, 4450, 4600, 4800, 4900) or any math (3450) or science course (3100, 3150, 3460, 3470, 3650) is allowed with <u>prior approval</u> of the advisory committee.

General Rules:

- -- At least 12 credits must be at or above the 600 level.
- -- At most 6 credits are allowed to be Special Topics or Special Problems.
- -- In addition to satisfying the MSEE coursework policies, the plan of study must be approved by the Advisory Committee and submitted before the end of the first year of study.
